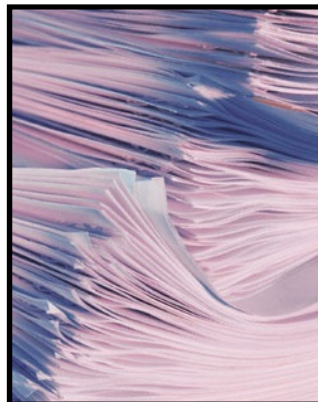

- **And so, we are left with rules that once made sense but don't now:**

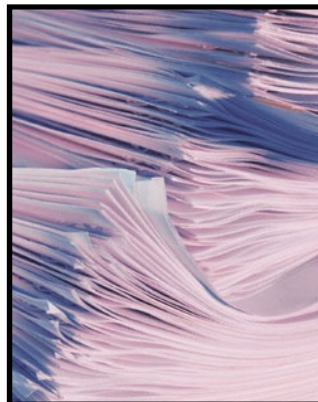
We must establish formal requirements contracts with our stakeholders.

- **And so, we are left with rules (continued):**

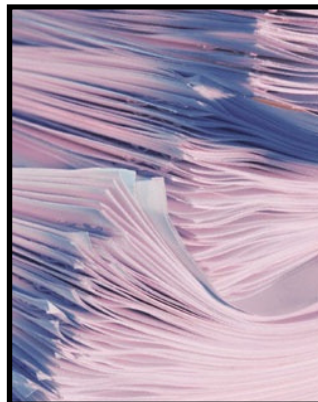
**We must establish detailed documentation
